Rural Catchments Described by School

Tate Creek Catchment:

- Northern boundary is the 198 roads and all side-roads. *This boundary jogs north along Highway 2 to Arndt road moving further east to include Simmons Road and on to the BC-Alberta boundary.
- Southern boundary is a line from the One Island Lake road where it crosses the Kiskatnaw, east to the BC-Alberta boundary.
- Western boundary is the Kiskatnaw River as it runs north and south.
- Eastern boundary is the BC-Alberta boundary, including portions of the Swan Lake watershed that extend into Alberta.

Pouce Coupe Catchment:

- Northern boundary is the East Pouce Road to the BC-Alberta boundary.
- Southern boundary is the Blockline Road and all side-roads, *crossing highway #2 to include Arndt road moving further east to include Simmons Road and on to the BC-Alberta boundary
- Western boundary is the Wallace Road and all side-roads. The boundary follows the East Pouce River north to its intersection with the East Pouce Road.
- Eastern boundary is the BC-Alberta boundary.

Devereaux Catchment:

- Northern boundary is Ralph Road (210) with the exception of Mason/Semple Road (237).
- Southern boundary is limit of the Upper Cutbank Road and all side roads extending west to the Brassey Creek Road.
- Western boundary is the Livingstone Road (251) and all side roads.
- Eastern boundary is Leach Road (235) running south to the Kiskatnaw River below Charlies' Road (191).

Parkland Catchment:

- Northern boundary includes the Gibbs/Newton (228) and Freisen (241) Roads (228) extending east to the confluence of the Peace and Kiskatnaw Rivers.
- Southern boundary is the Kennedy Loop extending north along 237 road turning east on the 214 road to Fredrickson Road (227) where it turns north again.
- Western boundary is the Kiskatnaw River from Kennedy Loop northwest, then following Braden road and continuing north to Gibbs, Newton, and Freisen Roads.
- Eastern boundary is north from Fredrickson Road (227A) road following the Kiskatnaw River to include the triangle road.

McLeod Catchment:

- Northern boundary is all side-roads north of Smithard Road (216) including Willow Valley Road and Wrangler Road (214).
- Southern boundary is all residences south of the John Hart Highway.
- Western boundary is the bridge at East Pine.
- Eastern boundary is the 253 Road.

Rolla Catchment:

- Northern boundary is the Peace River.
- Southern boundary is Sweetwater Road
- Western Boundary is the 231 Road north to the confluence of the Kiskatinaw and Peace Rivers.
- Eastern boundary is the BC-Alberta boundary.

* Note: Students on Simmons road and Arndt road fall into the catchment of both Pouce Coupe Elementary and Tate Creek Elementary and will choose which school their children will attend.

Municipal Catchment of Rural Students

Frank Ross Catchment:

Is the east side of an extension of 15th street in a line running north to Sweetwater Road, then running east to the BC-Alberta border, and south to the Spirit River road. The catchment follows the north side of the highway returning to the boundary of EFR's city catchment.

Crescent Park Catchment:

Is the west side of an extension of 15th street in a line running north to Sweetwater Road, then running west to 235 road and south to the John Hart Highway, including Reidell subdivision. The catchment follows the north side of the highway returning to the boundary of CP's city catchment.

Canalta Catchment:

Is the south side of the John Hart Highway going west to the 235 road, continuing south to Bear Mountain. The Bear Mountain catchment area includes the side-roads of the South Dawson Road (227), east to 17th St., including Ski Hill Loop and McKinnon Sub.

Tremblay Catchment:

Is all residences east of 17th St/Ski Hill Rd., and south of Highway #2 to Berry Road. This includes the residences along Berry Road, Peterson and Loiselle subdivisions.

Recommendation: That the Board of Education ratifies the catchment areas for municipal and rural catchment areas as described here.
