RE: Scooters and Bicycles

Dear Parents/Guardians:

The use of scooters and bicycles on school property has become a serious concern. Students have been reminded several times and by several staff that they are to walk their scooter/bike on school property. Before school and after school are busy times in the parking lot as well as other areas of school property. Several students have put themselves in dangerous situations by not following this policy. Several students have also argued with staff over whether they were "riding" or not. These situations were dealt with on an individual basis however they are becoming more frequent.

I spoke to students today and explained the rule as well as the reason for it. I was very specific about what "walking your scooter/bike" meant. Students had the opportunity to ask questions in order to ensure they understood the rule.

After school students are expected to walk their scooters/bikes to the crosswalk and walk them across the crosswalk. They are then free to scooter/bike away. Before school students need to walk their scooters/bikes when they step into the parking lot or onto school property.

Students have been told that if they would like to bring a scooter/bike to school they need to follow the rule. If they choose not to follow the rule they will not be permitted to bring a scooter/bike to school.

I am very concerned for student safety and hope that we can work together to ensure that students who ride their scooter/bike follow this rule in order to prevent anyone from getting injured.
