School Growth Plan

1. Students' reading levels will improve.

Actions

- a base line of current reading levels will be established in the Fall
- reading levels will be posted in a shared location
- reading levels will be measured in January and in June
- a database will be created whereby any teacher can check data for any student
- a common method for a Guided Reading lesson will be developed

Strategies

- primary classes will continue in the primary project with a special focus on grade 2 students (cohort)
- lagging skills in intermediate reading will be targeted
- incorporate reading strategy instruction into buddy reading
- the 0.4 literacy support through the Teacher Education Fund
- Reading Recovery
- reading blitz from 9:00-10:30 with multi-class groups (primary)

Target

- students reading levels will improve
- Grades 4-7: students will increase by one Fountas and Pinnell level (ex. 50 to 60)
- Grades 2-3: students will increase by 5 Fountas and Pinnell levels
- Grade 1: students will increase by 8 Fountas and Pinnell levels (A-I)

2. Students will improve their number sense.

Actions

- the district numeracy teacher will provide a workshop for staff on the curriculum implementation day which will provide possible strategies and benchmarks
- baseline data will be collected based on the benchmarks
- data will be collected in June based on the benchmarks

Strategies

- vocabulary for numeracy will be taught
- vocabulary will be placed on a bulletin board in the hall
- implementation of the strategies suggested by the numeracy teacher

Target

- 75% of students will be meeting expectations based on the benchmark
